



Choose the appropriate class.









Click "Draw" and select a type of shape. The example uses the Polygon option.




With the polygon option, click around the map to create the shape's border...











Alternatively, you can switch the shape so the properties within the polygon are EXCLUDED from search results. Click "Edit" next to "Draw."
